
Desert, Dangers and Divine Disinterest ... the Need to Pray Without Ceasing

From the wide ribbon of coastal habitations around our nation and beyond, journey to the Centre!

To a landscape characterised by dry sandy creek beds and giant caterpillar shaped ranges: yellow, red, brown: both light and dark.

In the traditions of Christian Meditation and Desert Spirituality imbedded in Biblical narrative, in a world characterised by the "indifference of God" and, one might add, of humanity, you are invited to a retreat in the heart of our nation.

The setting is the evocative landscape of Central Australia, including an excursion into the East MacDonnell ranges. The days will be marked by a rhythm of prayer, meditation and silence, with input from Fr Bernard with Bec Smith member of our meditation community www.wccm.org, reflecting on the day and sharing around the campfire in the evenings, with an opportunity to share in the Eucharist, and to walk the labyrinth, as well as an introduction to dadirri and other contemplative practices.

Sunday 25th afternoon -Friday 30th August 2024 There will be 3 levels of accommodation offered, numbers are limited in each level, all-inclusive prices for the 5 nights are:

- Private room \$995 per person
- Shared room \$695 per person
- Swag camping \$555 per person
- Extra nights can be requested on the registration form
- As well it's possible to come daily non residential, \$400 for all sessions and meals

Free accommodation (in a caravan) will be reserved for one volunteer, in exchange for their assistance throughout the event, and ideally arriving a few days before the retreat and staying on afterwards to assist with clean-up and preparing for next guests. Minimum 2-week volunteering stay.
